All applicants must provide a FY 10-11 application, copy of Board of Directors, 2008 financial audit on or before February 1, 2010.

Blount County will not accept applications for charitable contributions from any agency who did not receive contributions in the prior budget year.

Blount County will reduce the total amount allocated for charitable contributions by twenty five percent each budget year.
