AMENDED ORDER PERTAINING TO COURT SCHEDULES AND UPDATED COVID PROCEDURES

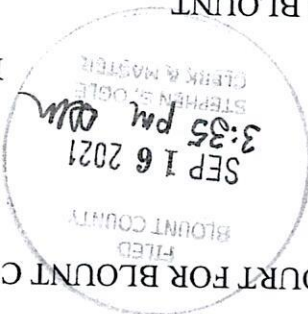

This Court's previous Order entered and filed May 17, 2021, as amended, is further amended as follows:

1. All previous Orders and Memoranda issued pursuant to said Orders remain in effect except to the extent modified herein.
2. The following measures will be in effect for all Justice Center court dockets beginning Friday, September 17 and continuing until further notice:
 - a. Masks or other appropriate face coverings must be worn by all persons attending court in Blount County, for both circuit and general sessions courts, beginning September 17.
 - b. Per CDC Guidelines: any attorney or other person who has been exposed to COVID-19 but is vaccinated and asymptomatic may attend court but must wear a mask at all times while in the Justice Center.
 - c. Also per CDC Guidelines: any attorney or other person who has been exposed to COVID-19 and is symptomatic, even if vaccinated, must quarantine.
 - d. Also per CDC Guidelines: any attorney or other person who has been exposed to COVID-19 and is unvaccinated must also quarantine.
3. This Order does not impact Juvenile Court proceedings which are governed by the orders of the Juvenile Court.
